Appellant was convicted for offence punishable under Sections 354, 324/34 and 323/34 of IPC vide judgment and order dated 18.03.2026, passed by the court of learned Additional Sessions Judge/FTC, Haridwar, District Haridwar in Session Trial No.13 of 2024, "State of Uttarakhand Vs. Praduman and another". Challenging his conviction and sentence, Appellant has filed this appeal.</p> <p>4.
