D1-08			<p><u>WPSS No.877 of 2026</u>  <b><u>Hon'ble Ravindra Maithani, J.</u></b></p> <p>Ms. Medha Pande, Advocate for the petitioner.</p> <p>Mr. Narayan Dutt, Standing Counsel for the State.</p> <p>Mr. K.K. Tiwari, Advocate for the respondent nos. 3 and 4.</p> <p>Heard.</p> <p>The petitioner was working as a salesman in Uttarakhand Khadi and Village Industries Board. During his service tenure, after some enquiry, it was revealed that there was some loss of stock. The petitioner was suspended on 26.06.2019, and chargesheet was served on the same date. Till date, enquiry has not been completed.</p> <p>What is surprising is that according to the petitioner, he has been superannuated on 31.08.2022.</p> <p>Challenge is made to the suspension, chargesheet, etc. The petitioner also seeks directions to the respondents to pay the provident fund, pension and other related dues.</p> <p>Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that after such a long time, yet the enquiry has not been completed; the department has withheld the amount, which they alleges against the petitioner, which is Rs.1,77,960/-, and release the remaining amount, which is due.</p> <p>Learned counsel for the respondent nos. 3 and 4 submits that the amount is about Rs. 2 Lacs with interest.</p> <p>Admittedly, till date, neither provisional pension nor any part of provident fund has been released to the petitioner. Why is it so?</p>

Why the amount that are payable immediately have not been paid to the petitioner till date?

Let learned counsel for the respondent nos. 3 and 4 get instructions on this aspect.

The concerned authority shall consider the release of the provisional pension and other dues, which may be released at this stage to the petitioner before the date fixed.

List this matter on 30.04.2026.
