This writ petition has been filed by the petitioners on the premise that the petitioners are working on teaching and non-teaching position in an educational institution i.e., Maharshi Dayanand Junior High School Khedajatt, Narsan, Haridwar since 2008. The said institution was brought under grant-in-aid on 28.02.2014.</p> <p>4. The petitioners were paid salary on their teaching and non teaching position since 01.02.2016.</p> <p>5. It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioners that as per Section 50 of The Uttarakhand School Education Act, 2006, the petitioner is entitled to get salary from the date when the Institution was brought under grant-in-aid, therefore, they are claiming arrears of that period between 28.02.2014 to 31.01.2016.</p> <p>6. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the controversy involved in the present writ petition has been set at rest by the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court vide judgment and order dated 06.08.2018, passed in WPMS No.1820 of 2017, <i>Manavta Higher Primary School, Gandhi Nagar, Bindukhatta, Nainital Vs. State of Uttarakhand</i>, which has attained finality as SPA preferred there against was also dismissed.</p> <p>7. Learned counsel for the State seeks 48 hours time to seek instructions in the matter and further to make a statement before this Court that as to whether the controversy involved in</p>

the present writ petition is covered by the judgment referred hereinabove or not.
