By the instant petition both the petitioners are praying for the following relief:<ol style="list-style-type: none">i. Issue a writ, order or direction in the nature of mandamus commanding and directing to the respondent nos. 1, 2 and 3 to provide security to the petitioners and they may be directed to ensure that the respondent no. 4 to 6 may not harass, threat and commit violation to the petitioners in any manner.4. Both the petitioners are present in court. It is contended that both infact were in love with each other and now married. Nikahnama is on record. About their age, the Aadhar card has been enclosed. It is submitted that there is threat perception from respondent nos. 4 to 6, who are close relatives of the petitioner no. 1 and, therefore, the adequate protection may be granted to them.5. Let both the parties may appear before the S.H.O. concerned, who will assess any threat perception and if he comes to the conclusion that there is any threat perception to the petitioners from respondent nos. 4 to 6 he may take appropriate steps in order to save their life and liberty.6.
