Mr. Rajendra Singh Azad, learned counsel (through V.C.) and Mr. Nagesh Agarwal, learned counsel for the revisionist.2. Mr. Nikhil Singhal, learned counsel for the respondent.3. The present revision has been filed assailing the order dated 07.02.2026 passed by learned Judge, SCC/1st Additional District Judge, District Haridwar in SCC Suit no.20 of 2024, whereby the application no.31c moved by the respondent/plaintiff under Order XV Rule 5 CPC and Section 151 CPC was allowed and the defence of the revisionist/defendant was struck off.4. Learned counsel for the respondent submits that SCC Suit No.20/2024, which is the subject matter of the present proceedings, has been finally decided on 15.04.2026 and as such the present revision has become infructuous.5. Learned counsel for the revisionist does not dispute the said fact. He, however, submits that he may be granted liberty to challenge or to make submission with regard to the rejection of application paper no.31C in further proceedings, which the revisionist may initiate against the final order dated 15.04.2026.

6. Since the SCC suit no.20/2024 has been finally decided on 15.04.2026, the revision preferred against the order of allowing the application under Order XV Rule 5 of C.P.C. has been rendered infructuous. Accordingly, the revision stands dismissed.
