3. On 08.04.2026, Mr. Jitendra Chaudhary, Advocate sought time to get instructions from the petitioners.

4. Today, Mr. Jitendra Chaudhary, Advocate submitted that an ad-interim injunction was granted to the respondents-plaintiffs. The temporary injunction application is still pending. He has requested on instructions from the petitioners to dispose of the present writ petition, directing the trial court to decide the temporary injunction application at the earliest.

5. In the facts and circumstances of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of directing the learned trial court to decide the temporary injunction application, filed in Original Suit No.27 of 2025, "Makhan Singh & Others vs. Sudhir Kumar and Others", as expeditiously as possible, as per law, but not later than four weeks' from the date of production of certified copy of this order.

6. It is made clear that this Court has not expressed any opinion on the merit of the case.
