Mr. Saurabh Kumar Pandey, learned counsel for the applicant.</li> <li>2. Mr. Sandeep Sharma, learned A.G.A. for the State.</li> <li>3. The instant anticipatory bail application has been moved on behalf of the applicant Mohd Ishak S/o Mohd. Faruk praying for anticipatory bail with reference to First Information Report dated 24.02.2026 bearing FIR No. 59 of 2026, which was lodged against seven persons including one unknown person for the offences punishable under sections 318(2), 319(2) and 61(2) of BNS, 2023 r/w section 3/9 of U.P. Public Examinations (Prevention Unfair Means) Act, 1998, P.S. Ranipur, District Haridwar.</li> <li>4. It is contended by the learned counsel for the applicant that the applicant is innocent and is not named in the FIR and two other co-accused Mr. Rajkumar and Munish Ali were granted interim bail by this court on 27.02.2026.</li> <li>5. Let the State may file their objection within three weeks.</li> <li>6. One week thereafter is granted to the applicant for filing response to the objection.</li> <li>7. List this matter on 01.06.2026 along with the connected matters.</li> <li>8. In the meantime, taking into consideration that the applicant is not named in the FIR and the investigation is still going on for an interim measure, it is directed that in the event of arrest of the applicant-Mohd. Ishak, he shall be released on interim bail on executing a personal bond of Rs. 30,000/- and two reliable sureties, each of the like amount, to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer concerned, subject to the following condition: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>i. Applicant shall cooperate with the investigating agency and he shall make himself available for interrogation by the police officer as and</li> </ol> </li> </ol>

when required.

ii. Applicant shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case.

iii. Applicant shall not leave the country without the prior permission of this Court.
