The respondent no.2 is the son of the respondent no.1. The respondent no.1 filed a case against the petitioner and her husband under the provisions of the Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizens Act, 2007 (Case No.67 of 2025). The Tribunal/Sub - Divisional - Magistrate (Sadar), Dehradun, while passing the judgment dated 23.01.2026, directed the petitioner to vacate the property of the respondent no.1. Hence, the present writ petition under Article 227 of the Constitution of India.</p> <p data-bbox="627 1317 1528 1420">2. Heard Mr. Sagar Kothari, learned counsel for the petitioner.</p> <p data-bbox="627 1453 1528 2033">3. Mr. Sagar Kothari, Advocate submitted that the petitioner has filed an Application under the provisions of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act 2005 (Misc. Case No.4411 of 2025) against the respondent no.1 and other family members of her husband. Learned Ist Additional Judicial Magistrate, Dehradun passed an order dated 12.01.2026 and restrained the opposite parties</p>

including the respondent no.1 to evict the petitioner from the property-in-question.

4. Notice is being issued to the respondent no.1. Steps to be taken positively within a week.

5. List on 30.04.2026. Till then, the effect and operation of the impugned judgment dated 23.01.2026, passed in Case No.67 of 2025, are kept in abeyance qua the petitioner-Smt. Geeta Bisht.
