Jaspur, District Udham Singh Nagar.</p> <p>4. Heard learned counsel for the parties.</p> <p>5. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that it is a case of parity. He submits that co-accused persons have already been enlarged on bail by this Court vide order dated 02.04.2026 in the similar offence and on the ground of parity applicant is entitled to be released on bail.</p> <p>6. Learned State counsel vehemently opposed the bail application.</p> <p>7. Having heard learned counsel for the parties, without going into the merits of the case, this Court is of the view that applicant is entitled to be released on bail.</p> <p>8. Accordingly, bail application is allowed.
