	17.04.2026		<p>WPMS No.945 of 2026  <b><u>Hon'ble Alok Kumar Verma, J.</u></b>  Nineteen individuals affected by the landslide natural disaster were identified and found suitable for land allotment by the order dated 01.07.2024, passed by District Magistrate, Dehradun. The order dated 01.07.2024 was challenged by the petitioners by way of a revision. The Board of Revenue has rejected the Revision (No.69 of 2024-2025) vide judgment dated 20.03.2026. Hence, the present writ petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India.</p> <p><b>2.</b> Mr. Arvind Vashistha, learned Senior Advocate assisted by Ms. Devanshi Joshi, learned counsel holding brief of Mr. Vivek Pathak, learned counsel for the petitioners.</p> <p><b>3.</b> Mr. K.S.
