The Applicant is in judicial custody in connection with FIR No. 168 of 2025, registered at Police Station Khatima, District Udham Singh Nagar, for the offences punishable under Sections 3(5), 61(2), 305(E), 317(2), 317(4), 317(5), 324(3), and 324(5) of the B.N.S., 2023, as well as Section 3(2)(a) of the Prevention of Damage to Public Property Act and Sections 136 and 137 of the Electricity Act.</p> <p>4. Learned counsel appearing for the Applicant submits that the present matter pertains to the alleged theft of electricity wire, which was recovered from the co-accused, who has already been enlarged on bail by the learned Trial Court. It is further submitted that the Applicant has been falsely implicated in the present case.</p> <p>5. Learned State Counsel, however, refutes the submissions so advanced by learned counsel for the Applicant, contending, firstly, that the Applicant has a criminal history, and secondly, that he was absconding and has active involvement in the theft in question.
