Applicant is aggrieved by the orders dated 17.05.2025 and 23.03.2026, whereby his application seeking setting aside of the ex-parte order has been rejected, and the Criminal Revision preferred thereagainst has also been dismissed. 3. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that no notice of the aforesaid proceedings was ever duly served upon the applicant. It is contended that this fact has been specifically averred in the application filed under Order IX Rule 13 C.P.C. However, the Revisional Court, while dismissing the revision, has erroneously observed that the applicant had not stated the said fact in his affidavit, despite the same having been clearly pleaded in the application under Order IX Rule 13 C.P.C. It is further submitted that in the event the impugned orders are not set aside and the applicant is not afforded an opportunity to cross-examine the respondent and to adduce evidence in support of his case, the applicant shall suffer irreparable loss and grave prejudice. 4. Issue notice to the respondent, returnable at an early date. 5. List the matter after receipt of the service report. 6. Considering the submissions advanced by learned counsel for the applicant, it is directed that, till the next date of listing, further proceedings of Misc. Criminal Case No.67 of 2025, pending before the Court of
