In these two petitions the petitioners who belongs to one family are challenging the proceedings arising out of two FIRs, first, dated 10.10.2023 bearing FIR No. 0098 of 2023 P.S. Banbasa, District Champawat and, second, on FIR dated 04.11.2025 bearing FIR No. 0112 of 2025 P.S. Tanakpur, District Champawat. The trial has already been commenced and now the compounding applications have been moved on the ground that the parties have settled their disputes and the respondent/complainant-the mother of the victim is not intended to pursue with the Trial, hence, the proceedings be quashed by allowing the compounding application.</li> <li>4. Learned A.G.A. apprise to this court that now the trial has already been commenced and requests that a week's time may be given to file objection.</li> <li>5. All the petitioners and the respondent/informant are present in court and their affidavits are also on record in support of the compounding application but since the objection has been from the prosecution, therefore, the matter is being posted after ten days.</li> <li>6. Since, the Coordinate Bench already stayed the proceeding of S.S.T. No. 20 of 2026 arising out of Case Crime No. 0112 of 2025, therefore, in C528 No. 799 of 2026 proceeding of SST No. 50 of 2023 arising out of Case Crime No. 0098 of 2023 is also stayed.</li> <li>7.
