The petitioner Tushar Goyal is praying for quashing of the First Information Report dated 29.07.2025 bearing FIR No. 0278 of 2025 Police Station Kotwali District Dehradun, wherein the petitioner, his mother, father and other relatives have been implicated for the offences punishable under Sections 323, 498-A 504 of IPC read with Section 3/4 Dowry Prohibition Act, 1961. <li data-bbox="660 1202 1423 1554">4. It appears that the dispute in between the petitioner and the respondent/complainant is arising out of the reasons as reflected from para no. 9 and 10 of the petition filed by the petitioner under Section 12 of Hindu Marriage Act, in the Court of Principal Judge, Family Court, Dehradun on 18.11.2023. <li data-bbox="660 1561 1423 1778">5. It is submitted by Mr. Bhupesh Kandpal that after more than one and half year of the petition filed under Section 12 of Hindu Marriage Act impugned FIR has been lodged by the respondent/complainant on 29.07.2025. <li data-bbox="660 1785 1423 1998">6. After gone through with the averments as made in the petition filed by the petitioner and the FIR, this Court is of the view that let the efforts may be made for amicable settlement in between the petitioner and

respondent no.2 so that either they may live together or to get permanent separation.

7. Let both the parties may appear before this Court on the next date fixed.

8. Learned counsel for the petitioner shall inform about the instant proceeding to the respondent/complainant through Whatsapp or e-mail so that on the next date she remain present in Court.

9. List this case on 06.05.2026 as fresh.

10. Till then, no coercive action shall be taken against the petitioner provided he cooperates with the investigation.
