Mr. Himanshu Sain, learned A.G.A. for the State. 3. Petitioners Sanawwar and Tasawwar both are real brothers praying for quashing of FIR dated 24.04.2026, bearing FIR/Case Crime No. 73 of 2026 registered at P.S. Jhabrera District Haridwar wherein they have been implicated for the offence punishable under Section 2/3 of U.P. Gangster and Anti Social Activities (Prevention) Act 1986. 4. It is submitted that against petitioner no. 1 there are only two cases that to relate to the Cow Progeny Act and there is only one case against petitioner no. 2. Petitioner no. 1 is on bail and petitioner no. 2 is on anticipatory bail. He submits that other two brothers are in judicial custody in relation to the impugned FIR. 5. On the other side Mr. Sain, learned A.G.A. for the State on instructions submits that against both the petitioners there are two cases. 6. Let respondent may file their objection within three weeks. One week thereafter is granted to the petitioner to file rejoinder affidavit. 7. List this matter on 08.06.2026. 8. In the meantime, let the investigation pursuant to the impugned FIR may go one, however, no coercive action shall be taken against the petitioner subject to this condition that both the petitioners shall report to the S.H.O. concerned of the nearest police station on every month and the concerned S.H.O. shall

record their presence failing which the S.H.O. shall apprise to this Court through the learned State Counsel.
