The instant revision has been preferred by Mr. Afsar Ali S/o Shri Sakhawat Ali against the judgment and order passed by the learned II Additional Session Judge, Nainital, in Criminal Appeal No. 68 of 2025, whereby, he has been convicted for the offence punishable under section 138 of N.I. Act with the sentence of three months rigorous imprisonment with the fine of Rs. 1,25,000/-. He submits that the conviction and the sentence is bad in law since the Trial Court acquitted the revisionist after examining the entire record and the evidence as well as the statement of witness but the same were not properly dealt with by the Appellate Court while convicting the revisionist. 4. As per office report, the revision is well within time. 5. Admit. 6. Summon the Trial Court record as well as the record of Criminal Appeal No. 68 of 2025. 7. Issue notice to respondent no. 2. 8. Steps be taken within a week. 9. List this matter on 04.06.2026. 10.
