The present criminal misc. application is filed with a prayer to quash and set-aside the chargesheet, summoning order as well as the entire proceedings of Criminal Case No. 557 of 2025, Praveen Kumar Vs. Smt. Nidhi and Others, pending in the court of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st, Roorkee, District Haridwar. 4. In this case, a complaint was filed by the respondent no. 2 wherein, it is alleged that when he went to the office, his wife took Rs. 23,450/- and some jewellery amounting of Rs. 1 Lakh from the house and went with the applicant. After investigation, chargesheet was also filed against applicant and his wife. 5. Learned counsel for the applicant would submit that even if averments made in the FIR are taken on its face value, then also, no case <i>prima facie</i> is made out against the applicant. 6. Heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record. 7. This Court finds some substance in the submission made by learned counsel for the applicants and having heard the submission, under the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is of the view that this matter definitely requires deliberation. 8. Issue notice to respondent no. 2, returnable within three weeks. Steps to be taken within a week.

			9. List after service report is received. 10. In the meantime, counter-affidavit(s), if any, be filed by the respondents. 11. After perusing the records and having heard learned counsel for the parties, under the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court, <i>prima facie</i>, is of the opinion and is satisfied that in the interest of justice, further proceedings of Criminal Case No. 557 of 2025, Praveen Kumar Vs. Smt. Nidhi and Others, pending in the court of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st, Roorkee, District Haridwar, shall remain stayed <i>qua</i> the applicant till the next date of listing.
