Mr. Ramji Srivastava and Ms. Stuti Pandey, learned counsel petitioner.</li> <li>2. Petitioner is challenging the FIR dated 21.04.2026 bearing FIR No. 0148 of 2026 wherein present petitioner has been implicated for the offences punishable under Section 120-B, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 IPC.</li> <li>3. It is argued by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the dispute is with regard to the sanction of map by the MDDA wherein as per allegation in the FIR, the petitioner has forged the signatures of the respondent no. 3 - complainant. It is further argued by the learned counsel for the petitioner that respondent no. 3 - complainant has raised an issue about his forged signature before the MDDA, however, the Development Authority has rejected his objection on the ground that this aspect cannot be looked into by the Development Authority and he can avail another remedy.</li> <li>4. Mr. Himanshu Sain, learned AGA accepts notice on behalf of respondent no. 1 and 2.</li> <li>5. Mr. Gaurav Nagpal, learned counsel accepts notice on behalf of respondent no. 3.</li> <li>6. Let respondents may file counter affidavit within four weeks. Two weeks, thereafter, is granted to the petitioner to file rejoinder affidavit.</li> <li>7. List on 30.06.2026.</li> <li>8.
