			<p><u>WPCRL No. 794 of 2024</u>  <b><u>Hon'ble Rakesh Thapliyal, J.</u></b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Mr. Mohd. Safdar, learned counsel petitioner.</li> <li>2. Petitioner is challenging the FIR dated 03.03.2026 bearing FIR No. 51 of 2026, Police Station – Khanpur, District - Haridwar wherein present he has been implicated for the offences punishable under Section 6 read with Section 11 of the Uttarakhand Protection of Cow Progeny Act, 2007 and under Section 11 (1) (d) of the Prevention of Atrocities Upon Animals Act, 1960.</li> <li>3. It is argued by the learned counsel for the petitioner that there is no allegation of slaughtering except transporting of beef against the petitioner.</li> <li>4. On the previous date, State was directed to get instructions in the matter. Today, Mr. Himanshu Sain, learned AGA for the State, on instructions submits that investigation is going on and uptil date only an allegation as against the petitioner is for transporting the beef.</li> <li>5. Mr. Himanshu Sain, learned AGA accepts notice on behalf of respondent no. 1 and 2.</li> <li>6. Issue notice to respondent no. 3.</li> <li>7. Steps be taken within a week.</li> <li>8. Let respondents may file counter affidavit within four weeks. Two weeks, thereafter, is granted to the petitioner to file rejoinder affidavit.</li> <li>9. List on 30.06.2026.</li> <li>10.
