			<u>ABA No. 145 of 2026</u> <u>Hon'ble Rakesh Thapliyal, J.</u> 1. Mr. Harshpal Sekhon, learned counsel for the applicant. 2. Ms. Sweta Dobhal, learned Brief Holder for the State. 3. Mr. Shariq Khurshid, learned counsel for the complainant. 4. Present applicant Husan Bano @ Husanjahan, W/o Faimuddin and her daughter Mehrin, W/o Mohd. Javed are praying for anticipatory bail in reference to FIR dated 14.03.2026, bearing FIR No. 97 of 2026 wherein both the applicants along with one Shahnawaz, Shakir and one unknown person were implicated for the offence punishable under Section 82 (2) of BNS 2023. 5. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the applicants that Shahnawaz is the husband of the deceased and was taken into custody and is in jail. The deceased committed suicide, and as per the post mortem report she died due to hanging and there is no sign of strangulation. He submits that present applicants are mother and sister of Shahnawaz, husband of the deceased, and they have been implicated in this case only because of the reason that on the date of the incident they were in the same house where the deceased has committed suicide. 6. On the other side, Mr. Shariq Khurshid, learned counsel who appears for the complainant submits that the deceased had committed suicide within six months of her marriage and therefore role of the present applicants cannot be ruled out. 7. Ms. Sweta Badola, learned Brief Holder for

			the State apprise to this Court that as per the written instructions there were no sign of strangulation, however, she submits that she will file objection within two weeks. 8. Let State Counsel may file objection within two weeks. 9. List this matter on 26.05.2026. 10. For an interim measure, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, in an event of arrest during investigation, the applicants shall be released on an interim anticipatory bail subject to furnishing of personal bond with two reliable sureties of the like amount, to the satisfaction of the arresting Officer subject to the following conditions:- (i) The applicants shall cooperate with the investigation; (ii) The applicants shall not approach any witness in any manner, whatsoever.
