Ms. Pushpa Bhatt, learned Deputy A.G. along with Mr. S.C. Dumka, learned A.G.A. for the State.</p> <p>3. Learned counsel for the applicants submits that respondent no. 2 lodged an F.I.R. against the applicants alleging that he used to sexually harass her minor daughter while she was going to and returning from school and, on several occasions, attempted to commit sexual assault upon her. It was further alleged that the applicants had committed rape upon the minor daughter. However, after due investigation, the allegations of rape were not found to be substantiated, however, the Investigating Officer submitted charge sheet against the applicants under Section 115(2), 191(2), 351(2) & 352 I.P.C.</p> <p>4. Learned counsel for the applicants further submits that the F.I.R. is false and fabricated, and that the Investigating Officer has not conducted a fair and proper investigation. It is contended that a dispute had arisen between the parties as sewage water from the complainant's tank was overflowing, causing inconvenience to the applicants and his family members, who are neighbours of respondent no. 2. When the applicants objected to the same,</p>

the complainant and her family allegedly misbehaved and manhandled the applicants and his family members. The said incident occurred on 03.01.2026 and was also reported in a newspaper on 04.01.2026. He further submits that the present F.I.R. is an afterthought, having been lodged on 11.01.2026, solely with the intent to harass and victimize the applicants. He further submits that the statements of the victim were recorded under Sections 180 and 183 of the B.N.S.S., and that the same contain material contradictions.

5. Issue notice to respondent no.2, returnable at an early date.

6. List the matter after receipt of the service report.

7. Considering the submissions advanced by learned counsel for the applicants, it is directed that, till the next date of listing, further proceedings of S.S.T. No.193 of 2026, pending before the Court of learned F.T..C./Additional Sessions Judge/Special Judge (POCSO), Rudrapur, District Udham Singh Nagar, shall remain stayed.
