Mr. Sumit Joshi, learned counsel for the revisionist. 2. Mr. Himanshu Sain and Mrs. Meenakshi Sharma, learned A.G.A. for the State. 3. The instant criminal revision has been preferred by the revisionist against the order of his conviction passed by the Trial Court under section 138 of N.I. Act with the sentence of one year simple imprisonment with the fine of Rs. 4 lakhs, which was already confirmed in the appeal. 4. As per the office report there is a delay of 7 days in preferring the revision. The delay is well explained. Consequently, the delay condonation application is allowed. The delay of 7 days is condoned. 5. Admit. 6. Summon the Trial Court record. 7. Heard on exemption application. 8. It is argued by the learned counsel for the revisionist that the revisionist was on bail during trial and seeking exemption because he is a senior citizen and aged about 67 years and will pay the complainant a sum of Rs. 50,000/- within a month. 9. In view of the submission as advanced by the learned counsel for the revisionist, the exemption application is allowed provided the revisionist shall pay a sum of Rs. 50,000/- to the complainant positively within one month. 10.
