			WPSS No.1210 of 2026 <u>Hon'ble Pankaj Purohit, J.</u> Mr. G.D. Joshi, learned counsel for petitioner. 2. Mr. Maneesh Bisht, learned Brief Holder for the State of Uttarakhand/ respondent Nos.1 to 6. 3. Petitioner, mother of government servant-Late Vinay Rana, moved this writ petition with a prayer to quash the order dated 13.12.2024 as well as the order dated 21.08.2025 passed by respondent Nos.4 and 3 (Annexure Nos.6 and 10 respectively to the writ petition), whereby, 50% claim of retiral benefits of petitioner's son were refused to petitioner. 4. It is contended by learned counsel for petitioner that son of petitioner-Late Vinay Rana was working with the respondent-department as Junior Assistant, who unfortunately died on 07.10.2022 leaving behind his wife respondent No.7 Smt. Sonu Bafila Rana, a minor daughter and parents including petitioner. 5. It is further contended by him that respondent No.7-wife of Late Vinay Rana was offered compassionate appointment in place of her deceased husband, but the retiral dues are still to be paid by the respondent-department. 6. He further submits that petitioner came to know that forged document in the shape of affidavit has been filed by

		respondent No.7 to the department stating therein that if entire payment of retiral dues would pay to respondent No.7-wife, there is no objection by the petitioner. 7. After getting said information, petitioner approached respondent No.5-Assistant Divisional Transport Officer (ARTO), Rishikesh, District Dehradun, by moving application/representation dated 17.12.2023 (Annexure No.5) clearly stating therein that no such NOC was given by the petitioner and requested to make the payment of 1/3 of the retiral dues in favour of petitioner. 8. Such representation of the petitioner has been rejected by respondent No.3 saying that in the Service Record of Late Vinay Rana, respondent No.7-wife has been shown as nominee. It is feeling aggrieved by the said order, petitioner is before this Court. 9. Issue notice to respondent No.7 returnable within four weeks. 10. Steps to be taken within 03 days. 11. Put up on 18.08.2026. 12. In between, respondents may file counter affidavit(s). 13. Till the next date of listing, disbursement of 1/3 share of retiral dues shall remain stayed.
