Ms. Priya Mewari, learned counsel for the revisionist. 2. Mr. Tumul Nainwal, learned A.G.A. for the State. 3. The instant criminal revision has been preferred by the revisionist Mohd. Mobin S/o Shri Banne against the judgment and order passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate/Civil Judge (Junior Division) Nainital in Complaint Case No. 77 of 2024 Gopal Singh Khati vs. Mohd. Mobin, whereby the revisionist has been convicted with the sentence of three months simple imprisonment with a fine of Rs.3,20,000/- which was also confirmed by the learned 2nd Additional Session Judge, District Nainital in Criminal Appeal No. 60 of 2025. 4. As per the office report the revision is well within time. 5. Admit. 6. Issue notice to the respondent no.2. 7. Steps to be taken within a week. 8. Summon the trial court record. <p><u>Heard on Exemption Application</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 9. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the revisionist that revisionist was on bail during trial and the maximum sentence as

awarded by the trial court is three months simple imprisonment with the fine of Rs. 3,20,000/- and revisionist is ready to pay a sum of Rs. 50,000/- within a month, therefore the revisionist be exempted from surrender.

10. In view of the submissions as made above, the exemption application is allowed subject to this condition that the revisionist shall pay an amount of Rs. 50,000/- to the respondent/complainant within one month.
