Learned counsel for the petitioners/accused would submit that the present case arises out of a matrimonial discord between the parties; that, the petitioners are innocent and have falsely been implicated in the instant case; that, the FIR lodged by the respondent/complainant is based on false and fabricated grounds as the allegations made therein are general and omnibus in nature and no specific role attributed to the petitioners, therefore, the entire criminal proceedings are unsustainable in the eyes of law and are liable to be quashed.</p> <p>5.
