The Chartered Accountant confirmed having issued the certificate through her e-mail on 20.04.2026. In the technical round, the bid of the petitioner has been rejected on the ground that there is mismatch of UDIN, as given in the certificate. According to the petitioner, there is no mismatch and in support of the said submission, he has placed on record the verification obtained online from the Institute of Chartered Accountants, filed at Page No.170 of the writ petition.
