Learned counsel for the applicants has supplied the Amendment Application before this Court today, which is placed on record.</p> <p>3. Defects, as pointed out by the Registry, are overruled.</p> <p>4. Learned counsel for the applicants would submit that marriage between applicant no. 1 and respondent was solemnized on 28.04.2024 and respondent spent only 36 days in the matrimonial house and thereafter she on her own sweet will left her matrimonial house and took all her belongings, jewellery, cloths, etc. and only the double-bed belonging to respondent was left in her matrimonial house. It is further submitted that respondent has filed an application under Section 144 of BNSS, notices on which, were sent to the applicants on 02.04.2026 and applicant no. 1 has put in his appearance in the said case. It is further submitted that on the same set of facts, just to victimise and harass the applicants, respondent has filed the Misc. Criminal Case under Section 12 of Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005.</p> <p>5. Heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.</p> <p>6. This Court finds some substance in the submission made by learned counsel for the applicants and having heard the submission, under the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is of the view that this matter</p>

definitely requires deliberation.

7. Issue notice to the respondent, returnable within four weeks. Steps to be taken within a week.

8. List this matter after service report is received.

9. Meanwhile, counter-affidavit, if any, be filed by the respondent.

10. Considering the submissions advanced by learned counsel for the applicants, it is directed that, till the next date of listing, further proceedings of Misc. Criminal Case No. 03 of 2026, Saumya Giri Vs. Akshay Goswami and Others, under Section 12 of Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005, pending in the Court of learned Judicial Magistrate/Civil Judge (Sr.Div.), Champawat, shall remain stayed *qua* the applicants.

11. Interim Relief Application made therefor stands disposed of.
