			<u>ABA No. 183 of 2026</u> <u>Hon'ble Rakesh Thapliyal, J.</u> 1. Dr. Kartikey Hari Gupta and Mr. Syed Kashif Jafri, learned counsel for the applicant. 2. Mr. Tumul Nainwal, learned A.G.A. for the State. 3. The present applicant Vinit Raj S/o Mr. Dinesh Singhis praying for anticipatory bail in reference to First Information Report dated 24.03.2026 bearing FIR No. 0055 of 2026 P.S. Prem Nagar, District Dehradun which was lodged for the offences punishable under section 103(1), 191(2), 3(5) read with Section 61(2) of BNSS, 2023. 4. It is argued by learned counsel for the applicant that the applicant is not named in the FIR however his name has been disclosed by those who are named in the FIR. He submits that the present applicant is pursuing his studies in Bachelor of Business Administration from Uttarakhand University Dehradun and he is in the IVth Semester and since there is an apprehension of arrest, therefore, he may be given the protection from arrest. He also submits that the other co-accused who are named in the FIR namely Hrithik Rajput and Shantanu have been granted interim bail and the objection have also been invited, therefore, the present applicant, though he is not named in the FIR may also be given same protection. 5. Mr. Tumul Nainwal, learned A.G.A. at this

			juncture, submits that so far as interim protection which the applicant is praying for, he has no objection on this, since he is the student and pursuing his studies, however he prays for and is granted two weeks time to file objection. 6. This Court is fully agreed with the submissions of Mr. Tumul Nainwal, learned A.G.A. 7. In such view of the matter, for an interim measure, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, in an event of arrest during investigation, the applicant shall be released on an interim anticipatory bail subject to furnishing of personal bond with two reliable sureties of the like amount, to the satisfaction of the arresting Officer subject to the following conditions:- (i) The applicant shall cooperate with the investigation; (ii) The applicant shall not approach any witness in any manner, whatsoever 8.
