Learned counsel for the Applicant submits that it is admitted that certain ATM cards and other bank-related documents were recovered from the possession of the Applicant. However, the prosecution has failed to establish any nexus between the Applicant and the alleged offence. It is further submitted that mere possession of ATM cards, cheque books, and other banking documents does not, by itself, constitute a criminal offence.</p> <p>4. Learned State Counsel, however, refutes the submissions advanced on behalf of the Applicant and submits that ten ATM cards, eight cheque books, and other bank-related documents were recovered from the possession of the Applicant. It is further submitted that approximately thirteen complaints are stated to be pending against him. Learned State Counsel, therefore, seeks time to file a detailed objection/counter affidavit to the present bail application.</p> <p>5.
