Habeas corpus petition has been filed for producing the corpus, Manpal Singh, who happens to be the husband of petitioner no.1 and the father of petitioner no.2, and who, according to the petitioners, has illegally been detained by respondent no.4.</p> <p>5. Learned State counsel was required to get instructions, he submits that the corpus is staying willingly with his son.</p> <p>6. Learned counsel for the petitioners would submit that there are some family disputes between respondent no.4 and the petitioners. Respondent no.4 happens to be the son of petitioner no.1 and brother of petitioner no.2. The respondent no.4 has forcibly detained the corpus, Manpal Singh within District Haridwar.</p> <p>7. The Court directs the Station House Officer, Police Station Bahadrabad, District Haridwar to produce the corpus, Manpal Singh, the father of respondent no.4 through video conferencing before this Court from the District Court Campus, Haridwar on 08.06.2026 at 10:30 AM so that he may join the proceedings of this Court</p>

through video conferencing.

8. The Court requests the District Judge, Haridwar, to facilitate the participation of the corpus, Manpal Singh, in the proceedings of this Court through V.C. as and when he is produced by the S.H.O., Bahadradabad.
