Mr. Rajesh Sharma, learned C.G.S.C. for the Union of India/respondent nos.2 to 5.</p> <p>4. By means of this writ petition, the petitioner has sought quashing of notice dated 09.05.2026 issued by respondent no.4 and notice dated 22.05.2026 issued by respondent no.5 respectively.</p> <p>5. By the notice dated 09.05.2026, the petitioner was called upon to remove the encroachment within a period of 7 days otherwise the encroachment shall be removed by the Railway Administration without any prior intimation. When the said encroachment was not removed by the petitioner a show cause notice dated 22.05.2026, annexure no.4 to the writ petition, was issued to the petitioner under Section 4 of The Public Premises (Eviction of Unauthorised Occupants) Act, 1971.</p> <p>6. It is admitted to the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has not given reply to the show cause notice dated 22.05.2026 and has straightway approached this Court.</p> <p>7. It appears that the respondent no.5-Railways has initiated legal proceedings for eviction of the petitioner from the unauthorized encroachment from the land of the railways, therefore, the petitioner should file a reply to the show cause dated 22.05.2026 before the Estate Officer.</p> <p>8. Accordingly writ petition stands disposed of and it is provided that the petitioner shall file a reply to the said show cause notice, in accordance with law, to the Estate Officer</p>

within further 7 days from today.

9. Let a certified copy of this order be supplied to the learned counsel for the parties, today itself, on payment of usual charges.
