The present Bail Application has been moved by the Applicant— Paritosh Nanda, S/o Late Deen Dayal Manchanda, R/o House No. 88, Ward No. 32, Bahuguna Colony, Ajabpur Khurd, Police Station Nehru Colony, District Dehradun, who is in judicial custody in connection with Case Crime No. 269 of 2026, registered at Police Station Nehru Colony, District Dehradun, for offences punishable under Sections 8/21/60 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.</p> <p>4. Learned counsel for the Applicant, for consideration of bail, at the outset, submits that the contraband allegedly recovered from the possession of the Applicant, namely smack (heroin), is of non-commercial quantity, weighing only 26.8 grams. It is further submitted that the recovery is a chance recovery. Learned counsel for the Applicant also contends that, as per the prosecution case itself, a weighing scale and certain instruments allegedly used for weighing the contraband were recovered from the vehicle of the Applicant; however, the said articles have neither been made part of the record nor produced as evidence by the prosecution.</p> <p>5. Learned State Counsel, however, refutes the said submissions and seeks time to file objections/counter affidavit.</p> <p>6.
