Mr. Deepak Bisht, learned Deputy Advocate General for the State.</p> <p>3. Present bail application is moved by the applicant, who is in judicial custody in connection with FIR/Case Crime No.164 of 2026 under Section 3/5/8 of Uttarakhand Protection of Cow Progeny Act and 3/11(1)(d) of the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act and 325, 61 of BNS at Police Station Jaspur, District Udham Singh Nagar.</p> <p>4. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that applicant has falsely been implicated in the matter; his name is surfaced only on the basis of the disclosure/confessional statement of the co-accused person; there is no recovery of any incriminating article, meat, weapon or vehicle from the possession of the applicant. He submits that no CCTV footage, call detail record, location evidence, electronic evidence or any other scientific material has been collected by the Investigating Agency. He submits that applicant belongs to a poor family and he is the only earning member of their family.</p> <p>5. Learned State Counsel has vehemently not opposed the bail.</p> <p>6. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is of the view that applicant is entitled to be released on bail.</p>

7. Accordingly, bail application is allowed. Let the applicant-Bhajan Singh alias Raje Singh be released on bail on his executing a personal bond and two reliable sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of the court concerned.

8. Pending application, if any, stands disposed of.
