The revisionist is challenging the order dated 13.05.2026 and 16.05.2026 passed by learned IInd Additional Civil Judge(J.D.)/Judicial Magistrate Roorkee, District Haridwar whereby child of one year and three months old is ordered to be admitted to prison with his mother. It is submitted by learned counsel for the revisionist that the revisionist being grandfather of the child is taking due care of child, therefore, it is not in the interest of child to admit him to be in prison with mother. 4. Let the revisionist along with the child and his wife may appear before the Chairman of the Child Welfare Committee Haridwar, tomorrow at 11.00 a.m., who will interact with the revisionist and his wife in order to assess the mind of the child then apprise to this Court that whether admitting the child in prison with the mother is in the interest of the child or not. 5. Thereafter, the Chairman shall join proceeding through V.C. in the presence of revisionist and his wife and child. The concerned Jail Authority shall also facilitate
