			CRLR No.416 of 2026 <u>Hon'ble Rakesh Thapliyal, J.</u> 1. Mr. Akshay Pradhan, learned counsel for the revisionist. 2. Mr. Tumul Nailwal, learned AGA for the State. 3. The Chairman of the Child Welfare Committee, Haridwar joined the proceedings through video conferencing along with the revisionist and the child as well as the mother who is in prison. He apprised to this Court that the mother of the child is agreeable that she may be permitted to meet or interact through video conferencing with the child every week and after being released on bail, permanent custody of the child be given to her. 4. When specific query was made from the revisionist, he strictly refused to hand over the custody of the child to the mother after being released on bail. Such an attitude of the revisionist cannot be accepted since the respondent Smt. Rachna is mother of the child, therefore, the child cannot be deprived to get love and affection from his mother. 5. At this juncture, the respondents submit that till such time she is in prison, she may be permitted to interact with the

			child through video conferencing but simultaneously the revisionist has to give an undertaking that as and when the revisionist shall be released on bail, the custody of the child be handed over to the respondent mother. 6. Let an affidavit be filed by the revisionist positively by 09.06.2026. 7. Put up on 10.06.2026 as fresh. 8. On 10.06.2026, all of them again with the Chairman of the Child Welfare Committee, Haridwar shall join the proceeding through video conferencing. 9. Till then, the revisionist shall not be compelled to give the custody of his child to the mother, who is in prison. (Rakesh Thapliyal, J.) 03.06.2026 Shiv/
