After receipt of the same, let the paper-book be prepared and supplied to the learned counsel for the parties on the payment of usual charges.</p> <p>5. Appellant was convicted for the offence punishable under Section 20 (b) (ii) (B) of the Narcotics Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, and sentenced to undergo five years rigorous imprisonment with a fine of Rs.50,000/-, and in default of payment of fine, additional simple imprisonment for a period of one year, vide judgment and order dated 25.05.2026, passed by the court of learned Special Sessions Judge, Champawat in Special Session Trial No.30/2022, "State Vs. Bhola Kashyap". Challenging his conviction and sentence, Appellant has filed this appeal.</p> <p>6. Learned counsel for the Appellant submits that the recovery of the contraband from the Appellant is below commercial quantity. He further submits that the Appellant was on bail during the course of trial and he has never misused the same.</p> <p>7. Considering the overall facts and circumstances of the</p>

case, the Appellant has made out a case for bail.

8. Consequently, the bail application is allowed. Let the Appellant/Applicant, be released on bail, on his executing a personal bond and furnishing two reliable sureties, each of the like amount to the satisfaction of the Court concerned.

9. List this matter on 10.08.2026.

10. It is made clear that grant of bail shall not be treated as a ground for seeking unnecessary adjournments or delaying disposal of the present criminal appeal.
