Kandpal, and Mr. Dinesh Chauhan, learned A.G.A. for the State of Uttarakhand.</p> <p>3. The present Bail Application has been moved on behalf of the Applicant, who is in judicial custody in connection with FIR No. 69 of 2025 (Sessions Trial No. 176 of 2025), registered at Police Station Gadarpur, District Udham Singh Nagar, for the offences punishable under Sections 3(5) and 103(1) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 and under Section 3/25 of the Arms Act, 1959.</p> <p>4. Learned counsel for the Applicant, while pressing for grant of bail, submits that the present matter is a case of parity as co-accused have been enlarged on bail; that though the present Applicant is roped in the present matter and being main accused he is alleged to have shot the fire resulting in the death of the deceased, the case is not so. It is further submitted that there are anomalies in the procedure of the investigation, mainly the grounds of arrest were communicated while his arrest.</p> <p>5. Learned State Counsel however refutes the submissions so advanced by learned counsel for the Applicant contending that the present Applicant is the main accused and in his case a fire arm, namely a country made pistol (<i>tamancha</i>), was recovered from his possession. He further prays for and is granted ten days' time to file objections/counter affidavit to the Bail Application.</p> <p>6. Let objections/counter affidavit be filed within ten days.</p> <p>7.
