Mr. Tumul Nainwal, learned A.G.A. with Mrs. Shweta Badola Dobhal, learned Brief Holder for the State. 3. The instant application has been moved under section 528 of BNSS, 2023, by the applicants Smt. Ranvir Kaur, Sri Rajiv Kumar Rhoda and Sidharth Rhoda challenging the proceeding of Criminal Case No. 7452 of 2025 'State vs. Sidharth Rhoda and Others' pending in the court of First Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Dehradun, arising out of First Information Report dated 18.10.2024 bearing FIR No. 0659 of 2024 lodged by the respondent no. 2, the wife of applicant no. 3, for the offences punishable under sections 498A r/w section 504 of IPC and Section 3/4 of Dowry Prohibition Act. 4. It is argued by the learned counsel for the applicant that the applicant no. 3 was in love with the respondent/complainant since last seven years and then they got married in the year 2023 and for almost one month they lived together, however due to matrimonial discord she left applicant no. 3 and now living at Noida where she is doing job and living separately. He submits that the applicant no. 3 is serving in Canada. He submits that earlier the respondent/complainant made a complaint to the Noida Police Station in which the mediation proceeding was drawn but subsequently the complaint was withdrawn, thereafter another complaint was filed at Dehradun and again mediation was drawn but she strictly refused to go with the husband and then she filed divorce petition in Dehradun seeking divorce on the ground of cruelty. Simultaneously, the applicant no. 3 also filed a petition under section 9 of Hindu Marriage Act for Restitution of Conjugal Rights. 5. Prima-facie the allegations appears to be a

			<p>matrimonial one, therefore, this court is of the view that the efforts may be made for their amicable settlement.</p> <p>6. Learned State counsel accepts notice for respondent no. 1.</p> <p>7. Issue notice to respondent no. 2.</p> <p>8. Steps be taken within a week through all mode including whatsapp and mail.</p> <p>9. Put up this matter on 08.07.2026.</p> <p>10. On that day both the applicant no. 3 and the respondent/complainant shall join the proceeding through V.C.</p> <p>11.
