This writ petition has been filed by the petitioner seeking a direction to the respondents to grant and release family pension to the petitioner w.e.f. 11.05.2011.</p> <p>7. The contention of the petitioner is that the mother of petitioner was working with the respondent No.7-University as Peon, who retired on superannuation on 31.05.1997. Petitioner's mother was granted pension by the respondents, however, she died on 25.02.2004 leaving behind petitioner-daughter and brother of the petitioner. Petitioner's brother was in service, who also expired. Petitioner is only survivor in the family.</p> <p>8. She claimed family pension from the</p> |

respondents being the unmarried daughter relying upon government order dated 11.05.2011 issued under the hand of Secretary Finance, State of Uttarakhand.

9. Learned counsel for petitioner submits that papers of petitioner for family pension have already been forwarded by respondent-University to the State of U.P., as the mother of petitioner retired before appointed date 09.11.2000. The shortcomings, which have been occurred in the papers of petitioner, have also rectified.

10. According to the learned counsel for petitioner, there is no impediment in the grant of family pension to the petitioner.

11. Learned counsel for respondent Nos.2 and 4 is directed to seek instruction from the State of U.P. as to by which time family pension would be sanctioned and granted to petitioner, within 15 days.
