This petition has been filed alleging that the respondent-contemnor has committed willful and deliberate non-compliance of the order passed by this Court on 08.08.2025 in WPSS No.218 of 2025, <i>Neha Chauhan vs. State of Uttarakhand & others</i>, which was disposed of on the statement made by the learned counsel appearing for the respondent-Commission, Mr. Shailendra Nauriyal, that the name of the petitioner could not be recommended due to a technical error identified by the Commission and the name of the petitioner would be recommended by the Commission shortly.</p> <p>3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though the order was passed in the presence of the counsel for the respondent-Commission and despite supply of the certified copy of the order to the respondent-contemnor on 08.12.2025, petitioner's name has still not been recommended.</p> <p>4. I have perused the order and it is evidently clear that the petition was disposed of on the statement made by the learned counsel appearing for the Commission. The respondent-contemnor has not recommended the name of the petitioner for the last ten months, <i>prima facie</i>, a case of contempt is made out.</p>

5. Issue notice to the respondent, returnable within two weeks.
6. Steps shall be taken within 24 hours.
7. List on 01.07.2026.
8. Respondent-contemnor shall file his response to the contempt petition or to comply with the order by recommending the name of the petitioner to the Government for appointment to the post of Assistant Teacher, L.T. Grade (Home Science).
