			<p>WPSS No.1498 of 2026 <u>Hon'ble Pankaj Purohit, J.</u></p> <p>Mr. Ravi Bisht, learned counsel for the petitioner.</p> <p>2. Mr. Rakesh Singh Kunwar, learned Additional C.S.C. for the State.</p> <p>3. Petitioner before this Court was working as Junior Engineer (contractual) with the respondent department. His services were extended from time to time. Now, petitioner has been discontinued from his contractual engagement as Junior Engineer with the respondent department.</p> <p>4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner had worked with the respondent department with utmost dedication and honesty for the last almost 10 years, and he could not have been dealt with in the manner as the department has dealt with him.</p> <p>5. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that in a similar situation, this Court and coordinate Bench of this Court have been pleased to grant interim protection to the petitioner of various writ petitions, inasmuch as if work and post is available, petitioners were allowed to continue as contractual Junior Engineer. The employer, however, shall be at liberty to supply the available vacancies by regular appointment.</p> <p>6. Since the controversy involved in those writ petitions is akin to the controversy involved in this writ petition, therefore, the same order is passed.</p> <p>7. If work and post is available, petitioner's claim for</p>

re-engagement as Junior Engineer shall be considered and he shall be allowed to continue as contractual Junior Engineer. However, employer shall be at liberty to supply available vacancies by regular appointment.

8. State Counsel may file his counter affidavit within six weeks.
