A serious allegation has been made in the present contempt petition against the respondents-contemnors that, despite having given an undertaking before this Court that, pursuant to the judgment passed by the Division Bench of this Court dated 18.02.2026 in WPSB No. 710 of 2024, <i>Praveen Tandon vs. State of Uttarakhand & Others</i>, and a batch of connected petitions, whereby the appointment of the Managing Director of PTCUL, namely Mr. P.C. Dhyani, had been set aside, and after the removal of Mr. P.C. Dhyani from the post of Managing Director of PTCUL, the charge of Managing Director was handed over to Mr. Meharban Singh Bisht till new Managing Director joined the post. The earlier Contempt Petition No.54 of 2026 was disposed of and the notices were discharged. However, vide order dated 15.05.2026, after the contempt petition had been closed, respondent no.2-contemnor, Mr. Meharban Singh Bisht, again handed over the charge of Managing Director to the Director (H.R.), namely Mr. P.C. Dhyani.</p> <p>3. From perusal of the record, and in particular, upon reading paragraph 5 of the order passed by the Contempt Court dated 30.04.2026 and the letter dated 15.05.2026, this Court is of the view that the respondents are playing</p>

fraud upon this Court by acting in such a strange manner, which may amount to conduct of respondents/contemnors contemptuous in nature.

4. Issue notice to the respondents-contemnors, returnable within four weeks.

5. Steps shall be taken within one week.
