Pal, learned A.G.A. along with Mr. Manoj Bhatt and Mr. Nikhil Bisht, learned Brief Holders for the State. 3. By means of the present writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, the petitioners seek issuance of a writ, order or direction in the nature of certiorari for quashing the First Information Report being F.I.R. No. 0174 of 2026 dated 07.05.2026, registered under Section 3/4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act, 1961 and Sections 115(2), 351(2), 352 and 85 of the B.N.S. at Police Station Jaspur, District Udham Singh Nagar. 4. Learned counsel for the petitioners would submit that the dispute in question arises out of matrimonial discord between petitioner no.1 and respondent no.4, who are husband and wife respectively. It is contended that the allegations made in the impugned F.I.R. regarding demand of dowry, cruelty and harassment are wholly false and vexatious. 5. Learned counsel would further submit that the petitioners are innocent and have been falsely implicated on account of strained matrimonial relations between petitioner no.1 and respondent no.4. It is submitted that respondent no.4 has been continuously creating discord and differences not only with petitioner no.1 but also with his family members. It is

			further contended that petitioner no.1 had instituted a petition seeking dissolution of marriage before the competent Family Court on 05.12.2025 and summons in the said proceedings were duly served upon respondent no.4 on 09.12.2025. Immediately thereafter, and as a counterblast to the matrimonial proceedings initiated by petitioner no.1, respondent no.4 lodged the impugned F.I.R. on 07.05.2026 with an ulterior motive to wreak vengeance and to exert pressure upon the petitioners. 6. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and perused the material available on record. 7. Issue notice to respondent no.4, returnable at an early date. 8. List this matter immediately after receipt of the service report. 9. Considering the submissions advanced on behalf of the petitioners and having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, as an interim measure, it is directed that till the next date of listing, petitioner shall not be arrested pursuant to F.I.R. No. 0174 of 2026 dated 07.05.2026, registered at Police Station Jaspur, District Udham Singh Nagar. 10. The interim relief application stands disposed of accordingly. (Alok Mahra, J.) 15.06.2026
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
