By means of present contempt petition, petitioner alleges the willful and deliberate contempt of this Court's order dated 10.10.2018 passed in WPSS No.1550 of 2018 and batch of writ petitions, wherein, the number of writ petition filed by present petitioner was WPSS No.1550 of 2018, <i>Sakshi Bahuguna v. State of Uttarakhand and others</i>. Those writ petitions were disposed of in terms of judgment and order dated 11.12.2012 passed by the Division Bench of this Court in SPA No.258 of 2012, <i>Balraj Singh Negi v. State and another</i>, whereby the appeal was allowed and the State Government was directed to pay difference of remuneration to the appellant within three months from the date of judgment, and to continue to pay remuneration to appellant in accordance with the directions contained in letter dated 30.12.2008, until such time, appellant continues to discharge duties as a contract faculty.</p> <p>3. Learned Counsel for petitioner submits that petitioner is also a contractual Instructor with the respondent-State in I.T.I. Pabau, District Pauri Garhwal. It is further contended that the order dated 11.12.2012 passed by the Division Bench attained finality up to Apex Court wherein the Special Leave Petitions were dismissed, and review petition also came to be rejected on 11.11.2025.
