This writ petition is filed by Rice Miller Welfare & Development Society, which is reportedly registered under Societies Registration Act, 1860. 6. Learned counsel for the respondent no. 6 submits that there are large number of persons who would be benefited by order, if any, passed in this writ petition; however, petitioner has not enclosed the list of members of petitioner's society. It is further contended that each of the members is liable to pay separate court fee, as individual relief would be claimed by each of the member. 7. In such view of the matter, petitioner is

Petitioner shall thereafter pay separate court fee in respect of each of the members within one week thereafter.
