By means of the present writ petition, petitioner seeks quashing of F.I.R./Case Crime No.0153 of 2026, under Section 137(2), 351(3) and Section 352 of B.N.S., 2023, registered at Police Station Kunda, District Udham Singh Nagar. 3. An F.I.R. was lodged by the complainant alleging that his daughter had been enticed away by the petitioners and that, at their instigation, she had left her parental home carrying jewellery and cash amounting to ₹1,50,000/-. 4. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have been falsely implicated in the present case. It is contended that the daughter of the complainant is a major and competent to take decisions of her own volition. He further submits that the petitioners neither induced nor persuaded her to leave her parental home, nor did they instigate her to carry any jewellery or cash. 5. Admit. 6. Issue notice to respondent no.3, returnable at an early date, by registered post, acknowledgment due.

Considering the submission advanced by learned counsel for the petitioners, it is directed that, till the next date of listing, investigation pursuant to the impugned F.I.R. may go on, however, petitioners shall not be arrested, provided they cooperate with the investigation. 9.
