			<u>CRLR No. 460 of 2026</u> <u>Hon'ble Alok Mahra, J.,</u> Mr. Gaurav Singh, learned counsel for the revisionist. 2. Exemption Application (IA No. 01 of 2026) has been filed praying that the revisionist be exempted from surrendering pursuant to the judgment and order dated 10.12.2025, passed by the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Haridwar in Criminal Complaint Case No. 3914 of 2024, as affirmed by the judgment and order dated 10.06.2026 passed in Criminal Appeal No. 03 of 2026. 3. It is submitted that the revisionist remained on bail throughout the course of the trial as well as during the pendency of the criminal appeal. He never misused the liberty granted to him and neither absconded nor violated any of the conditions imposed by the courts below. 4. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, and particularly the fact that the revisionist never misused the liberty granted to him while on bail, the exemption application is allowed. The revisionist is exempted from surrendering before the concerned Court, subject to the condition that he shall deposit a sum of Rs. 1,00,000/- within a period of three weeks. 5.
