By means of the present writ petition, petitioner seeks quashing of F.I.R./Case Crime No.0195 of 2026, under Section 105 of B.N.S., 2023, registered at Police Station Haldwani, District Nainital.</p> <p>3. Learned Senior Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is presently working as Manager (Finance & Business Development) with M/s M & M Logistic Solutions, a Delivery Partner of Amazon. It is submitted that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case and has no role in the day-to-day supervision, management, or control of the warehouse concerned. It is further submitted that the incident in question pertains to a fire that broke out in the warehouse of the company. According to the petitioner, the said incident occurred on account of negligence on the part of the caretakers and other personnel stationed at the warehouse, who were allegedly charging electric bikes and e-rickshaws inside the premises. It is contended that an electrical short circuit/sparking during the charging process resulted in the outbreak of fire. Learned counsel further submits that the petitioner was neither</p>

present at the site at the relevant time nor entrusted with any responsibility relating to the maintenance, safety, or operational management of the warehouse. It is thus argued that no prima facie material exists to connect the petitioner with the alleged occurrence and his implication in the F.I.R. is wholly unwarranted.

4. Admit.

5. As prayed, four weeks' time is granted to learned State Counsel to file counter affidavit.

6. List on 28.07.2026.

7. Considering the submission advanced by learned counsel for the petitioner, it is directed that, till the next date of listing, investigation pursuant to the impugned F.I.R. may go on, however, petitioner shall not be arrested, provided he cooperates with the investigation.

8. Stay application (I.A. No.1 of 2026) stands disposed of.
