Respondents. <u>Hon'ble Alok Mahra, J.,</u> Mr. Akshay Pradhan, learned counsel for the petitioner. 2. Mr. Vijay Pal, learned A.G.A. for the State of Uttarakhand. 3. By means of the present writ petition, the petitioner seeks quashing of the First Information Report dated 24.03.2026, registered as FIR No. 0050 of 2026, under Sections 318(4), 351(2) and 352 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, at Police Station Jhabrera, District Haridwar. 4. As per the allegations contained in the impugned FIR, an agreement for the sale of land was executed between the complainant and one Kulwinder Singh. The total sale consideration of the property was fixed at ₹10 crores. It is alleged that after receiving a sum of ₹9,60,00,000/- from the complainant, Kulwinder Singh failed to execute the sale deed in favour of the complainant. 5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that, as per the allegations contained in the FIR, the only role attributed to the present petitioner is that of a middleman/broker in the transaction. No allegation has been levelled against the petitioner regarding receipt of any part of the sale consideration or any wrongful financial gain. 6. Learned State Counsel, on instructions, fairly submits that the role attributed to the petitioner in the FIR is confined to that of a broker. 7. Learned State Counsel, on the basis of written instructions received from the Investigating Officer, further submits that no material has surfaced during the investigation to indicate that the petitioner derived

		any financial benefit from the alleged transaction. 8. Heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the material available on record. 9. Having considered the submissions advanced by the learned counsel for the parties and upon perusal of the material available on record, this Court is of the <i>prima facie</i> opinion that the matter requires consideration. 10. Issue notice to respondent No. 3, returnable within four weeks. 11. List this case after receipt of the service report along with WPCRL No. 576 of 2026. 12. Counter affidavit, if any, be filed by the respondents within the aforesaid period. 13. Till the next date of listing, as an interim measure, the petitioner shall not be arrested in connection with FIR No. 0050 of 2026 dated 24.03.2026, registered under Sections 318(4), 351(2) and 352 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, at Police Station Jhabrera, District Haridwar, provided that he cooperates with the investigation and appears before the Investigating Officer as and when required. 14.
