The present Application has been filed by the applicant-Wasim alias Chand seeking anticipatory bail in Case Crime No.306 of 2025, registered at Police Station Kichha, District Udham Singh Nagar.

2. The First Information Report was registered under Sections 124(2), 351(2) and Section 352 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.

3. According to the First Information Report dated 20.09.2025, the applicant hit the informant's father on his genitals on 03.09.2025. He was admitted to the hospital on 13.09.2025. His operation was done on 15.09.2025. One of his testicles was removed in the operation.

4. Heard Mr. M.K. Ray, learned counsel for the applicant and Ms. Manisha Rana Singh, learned Deputy Advocate General for the respondent.

5. Mr. M.K. Ray, Advocate, submitted that the applicant has been falsely implicated in the present matter. The delay in lodging the FIR creates serious doubt over the story of the First Information Report. The offence under Section 124(2) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 is not made out. Applicant is a permanent resident of District Udham Singh Nagar.

6. Ms. Manisha Rana Singh, learned Deputy Advocate General, submitted on instructions that the investigation is pending for the offence under Sections 118(2), 351(2) and Section 352 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023. She has sought three weeks' time to file objection to the Anticipatory Bail Application.

7. Time is granted.

8. Having heard the submissions of learned counsel for the parties and in the facts and circumstances of the case, as an ad-interim measure, it is directed that in the event of arrest of the applicant Wasim alias Chand, he shall be released on interim bail on executing a personal bond of Rs.30,000/- and two reliable sureties, each of the like amount, to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer/ Arresting Officer, subject to the following conditions: -

- (i) Applicant shall cooperate with the Investigating Agency and he shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;
- (ii) Applicant shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of this case.
- (iii) Applicant shall not leave the country without the previous permission of this Court.

9. List on 14.11.2025 for hearing on the Anticipatory Bail Application.
